

## GDHA TABLE CLINIC GUIDELINES

### TABLE CLINIC ENTRY DEADLINE: October 1, 2009

1. Professional attire is necessary. Uniforms and lab coats are acceptable.
2. Handouts should be available and include title of clinic, date and bibliography. **Handouts given to judges should have school name covered.** A minimum of 50 handouts must be available and include title of clinic, date, dental hygiene affiliation and bibliography.
3. Only one 3ft. x 6ft. table will be permitted for each table clinic.
4. All clinics are conducted at individual tables.
5. Advertising matter, commercial promotion, and solicitation of sales of any type is prohibited.
6. Drugs must be identified by their generic or chemical formula, rather than by commercial trade name.
7. Any trade name or product name should be covered.
8. Clinicians must supply all equipment, except the table, cloth cover, identification sign, and two chairs. Electrical outlets, AV equipment, etc. must be ordered directly from the supplier. An order form will be forwarded to each accepted table clinic presenter. Charges for this equipment are the responsibility of the clinicians to be paid at application.
9. Clinicians are not permitted to use patients or live models for treatment or demonstration.
10. Sound devices of any kind are not permitted.
11. Clinicians must have completed set-up of their table clinic 15 minutes prior to commencement of judging. All table clinics must be dismantled immediately following the public viewing. Please note: Clinicians *must remain at their clinics at all times*, as judging times may overlap with the public viewing time. **NO CELL PHONES during presentations.**
12. Charts or diagrams must be constrained to the tabletop. Easels will not be provided and no materials are allowed in the aisles.
13. Presentations must not exceed seven (7) minutes.
14. **All clinicians must be student members of ADHA (SADHA)** when submitting applications to participate in the table clinic program.

## GDHA RESEARCH POSTER CONTEST GUIDELINES

**RESEARCH POSTER CONTEST ENTRY DEADLINE: October 1st, 2009**

1. Professional attire is necessary. Uniforms and lab coats are acceptable.
2. Handouts should be available and include title of clinic, date and bibliography.  
**Handouts given to judges should have school name covered.** A minimum of 50 handouts must be available and include title of research poster, date, dental hygiene affiliation and bibliography.
3. Charts/posters/diagrams must be constrained to the billboard provided. Please note the billboard is 4' x 8'.
4. All posters are conducted on individual billboards.
5. Advertising matter, commercial promotion, and solicitation of sales of any type are prohibited.
6. Drugs must be identified by their generic or chemical formula, rather than by commercial trade name.
7. Any trade name or product name should be covered.
8. Presenters must supply all equipment, except the billboard, cloth cover, identification sign, and two chairs. Electrical outlets, AV equipment, etc. must be ordered directly from the supplier. An order form will be forwarded to each accepted research poster presenter. Charges for this equipment are the responsibility of the clinicians to be paid at application.
9. Presenters are not permitted to use patients or live models for treatment or demonstration.
10. Sound devices of any kind are not permitted.
11. Presenters must have completed set-up of their table clinic 15 minutes prior to commencement of judging. All research posters must be dismantled immediately following the public viewing. Please note: *Presenters must remain at their billboards at all times*, as judging times may overlap with the public viewing time.  
**NO CELL PHONES during presentations.**
12. Charts or diagrams must be constrained to the billboard. Easels will not be provided and no materials are allowed in the aisles.

13. Presentations must not exceed seven (7) minutes.
14. **All presenters must be student members of ADHA** when submitting this application to participate in the research poster session program. Up to two presenters are allowed for each research poster session.
15. Presenters must have been directly involved in conducting the research study presented.
