Online Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene

An online A.S. to B.S. completion degree for registered dental hygienists. Applications open mid-Spring for Fall 2021 enrollment. (See <https://lewis.gsu.edu/dental-hygiene/admission-requirements>.)

Earning a B.S. in dental hygiene opens new job opportunities for hygienists beyond direct patient care in a dental office. Graduates may manage a dental practice or a public health clinic. They may become more in demand in private dental clinics or teach dental hygiene in a technical college. A B.S. is also a stepping-stone for those interested in research or teaching at the college or university level. These dental hygienists will need a graduate degree, and a bachelor's degree is required before advancing.

The B.S. in dental hygiene includes ten courses designed to provide necessary coursework for graduates to advance in the profession. All courses are online and are three credit hours each.
